#### PUBLIC/PRIVATE RESILIENCY

**Dr. Paula Scalingi**, Executive Director for the Bay Area Center for Regional Disaster Resilience, which promotes and empowers public/private collaboration to improve all-hazards resilience. She also is President of The Scalingi Group, LLC, managing projects to improve infrastructure security and resilience, and Adjunct Associate Professor at Georgetown University. Previously, she was Director, Center for Regional Disaster Resilience of the Pacific Northwest Economic Region, a consortium of 10 states & provinces. Her activities focus on infrastructure interdependencies; energy, transportation, water systems, manufacturing, communications/IT, and health resilience; information sharing/situational awareness; supply chains, dam/levee resilience, and climate change resilience.
